NONDISCRIMINATION

This Board is committed to a policy of nondiscrimination in relation to race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, or disability in admission or access to, or treatment, or employment, in its educational programs or activities. This policy shall prevail in all of the Board's policies concerning staff, students, educational programs and services, and individuals with whom the Board does business.

The District shall promote good human relations by removing any vestige of prejudice and discrimination in employment, assignment, and promotion of personnel, and in the suitability and availability of programs for the youth of the District.

The public schools have an obligation to help children know and appreciate different cultural backgrounds. Therefore, the District shall continue to re-examine its policies, procedures, and programs to determine their effect on individual and group behavior, and shall make whatever changes are necessary to improve human relations. It is the Board's intent that all parts of the curriculum emphasize positive human relationships.
