**EMERGENCY PLANS  
(PREPAREDNESS PLAN)**

School districts are uniquely charged with responsibility for the education and welfare of children. To ensure the fulfillment of this obligation, the Board shall adopt an Emergency Preparedness Plan based on guidelines offered by the Office of Civil Defense.

The effectiveness of the plan will depend on the familiarity of the staff with the plan and its practical application through drills and discussion with pupils. The plan shall be subject to review on an annual basis and shall be considered an addendum to the policies and regulations of the Board. Amendments of the plan may be accomplished by suggesting revision to the superintendent.

The Board shall review the plan annually and will inspect the alarm systems and other preparedness facilities as part of its inspection of school buildings.

The plan shall be covered in teacher orientation programs and inservice training sessions at its inception and shall be reviewed annually at faculty meetings.

Each school principal shall hold periodic drills to ensure orderly evacuation of students in events of a bonafide emergency.
