TOBACCO USE ON SCHOOL PREMISES

The Board of Trustees of Big Horn County School District Number One is committed to providing a safe and healthful environment for all students, staff, and patrons of the District. To carry out the goals of the District's health curriculum regarding the use of alcohol and drugs, including tobacco, and to promote the health and safety of all students, staff and patrons of the District, and in order to comply with federal mandates, the Board adopts the following policy restricting the use of tobacco on school premises.

The Board of Trustees designates and directs that all school District properties and premises shall become tobacco-free environments, effective January 1, 1995. For the purposes of this policy, property and premises are defined as:

1. all school buildings and structures including, but not limited to, school/administration building, gymnasiums, auditoriums, bus maintenance garage, warehouse, and any other District structures;
2. all District vehicles and buses;
3. the football/track stadium and associated facilities;
4. all grounds and parking lots.

The Board recognizes the considerable addiction associated with tobacco use. This policy addresses addiction and the obvious health and safety aspects of tobacco use. By giving notice prior to the policy effective date, all tobacco users will be given time to make necessary adjustments or arrangements.
