**EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

The Board believes that student activities at school are a vital part of the total educational program, and should be used as a means for developing wholesome attitudes and good human relations, as well as knowledge and skills.

Therefore, the schools shall provide a program of co-curricular and interscholastic activities geared to the various age, interest, and ability levels of students. The establishment, as well as the elimination, of such programs shall require approval by the board.

The following shall serve as guides to the development of student activities:

1. Most activities should be an outgrowth of curriculum activities.
2. All participation shall be voluntary.
3. All activities shall be supervised; all clubs and groups shall have a faculty adviser.

Expenses necessary for a student's participation in extracurricular activities shall be paid from the general funds of the district. These expenses shall include the cost of transportation, meals other than the first, lodging, and equipment on approved activity trips. Any other expenses must be approved by the Board. Reimbursement for expenses shall be in accordance with rates established by the Board.
