**JUNIOR HIGH / MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETIC PROGRAMS**

Section 1. Philosophy for Jr. High/Middle School Sports

Our school district believes that at the Jr. High/Middle School level it is important for each student to have the opportunity to participate in athletics. In order to give each student that opportunity, we encourage them to participate in the team sports offered at the Jr. High/Middle School. Sixth, Seventh, and eighth grade students shall be allowed to participate in approved team sports sponsored by the district for Jr. High/Middle School.

Our most important mission is for the students to have the opportunity to participate and still have our schools be as competitive as possible.

Section 2. Approved Team Sports

Football, Basketball, Wrestling, Cross-country and Track are approved sports for boys.  
Volleyball, Basketball, Cross-country and Track are approved sports for girls.

Section 3. Conference Membership

Burlington Jr. High and Rocky Mountain Middle School shall affiliate with the Big Horn Basin Junior High School Athletic Conference, and shall adhere to its rules and by-laws.

Section 4. Practices

No practice shall begin earlier than the first day of school.

Section 5. Length of Season

The season for each sport shall be as set by the Conference.

Section 6. Number of Games

Normally no more than two games per week shall be played. If games are cancelled because of unavoidable emergency conditions, make-up games may be scheduled at times mutually agreeable with the approval of the school principal. No games shall be scheduled after the Conference tournaments.

Section 7. Travel

School time will be allowed for travel to games, but games must be played after school. Tournament games are excepted from this rule.
